Per the ordinance the canopy would be closer to the road then the 30 ft. required. The station would have above ground tanks and all work done and maintained by the owners. 4: Bids were received to fix the catch basins on Colfax St, French St., and Ames St. and fixing the holes on French and Ames St.'s. from Iron Horse Excavation LLC in the amount of \$15,697.15 The pipes on Ames St. were t.v.'d and everything looks good. Will made a motion to accept the bid and second by Susie. 6 yeas 0 nays. Motion carries.
