Pledge of Allegiance

Approval of May 11, 2026 minutes made by Bob and second by Will. 6 yays 0 nays motion carries.

Treasures Report: Kelli presented with the council the monthly detailed transaction report. She also would like the council to approve a motion to allow the sewer fund to take an Interest free loan from the major fund in the amount of \$70,000 to be paid in three months. Brandon made a motion to allow the sewer fund to borrow money from the major fund in the amount of \$70,000 and Sherry seconds. Sherry Made a motion to accept the treasurer's report and Bob seconds 6 yays 0 nays motion carries.

New Business: 1) Francis D'Huyvetter, Deputy director of Eaton County 911, spoke with the council about the upcoming 911 millage. 2) Dennis and Chad both got bids for the catch basins on Colfax St. and Ames St. SIS Was the only company that put a bid in writing. The bid was \$7964. Will made a motion to accept the bid from SIS and Brandon seconds 6 yays 0 nays motion carries.

Old Business: Committee Report; Sherry Is still working on some lights that are having issues. Greg would like Dennis to contact whoever paved Charlotte St. and see if they will repair it due to it still being fairly new.

Maintenance report: Chad Is having problems with IAI not doing what they promised to do regarding the pumps at the lagoons. He also stated the small mower needs to be replaced. He will get bids on 3 different brands. He will also get bids from three different lawncare companies for mowing in case the small mower breaks before we can get a new one. He states the lagoons are in good shape. He has been hauling scrap metal out of the elevator property.

Ordinance violation report: John has sent out 10 Ordinance violation letters.

Miscellaneous: Brandon would like to know what it is taking so long to sign the lease on the elevator property.

Limited public comment. Tod Burton feels the property at 345 Main St. should be up for public bid before we sign a lease to anyone else. Ben Dawson, with Eaton County Controller, presented the council plans for millages that will be on the ballot in November.. They are working on trying to get services back that were lost due to budget cuts. District

Court Judge Hon. Adrienne Van Langevelde present to discuss the mileages concerning juveniles that will be on the ballot . Eaton County Commissioner Andy Shaver also present to discuss the mileages.
